

#### The Internet facilitates International Manipulation of Domestic Politics

People have started to worry about computer attacks by terrorists. They should worry more about state-sponsored interferences into other countries' electronic politics.

#### The Internet will make politics more expensive and raise entry barriers

Direct democracy puts a premium on resources of mobilization, favoring money and organization. It disintermediates elected representatives. It favors sensationalized issues over "boring" ones.

The Internet will make reasoned and informed political dialog more difficult Political information becomes distorted, shrill, and simplistic.

Information does not necessarily weaken the state

Direct access to public officials will be phony
